

How do I Register?

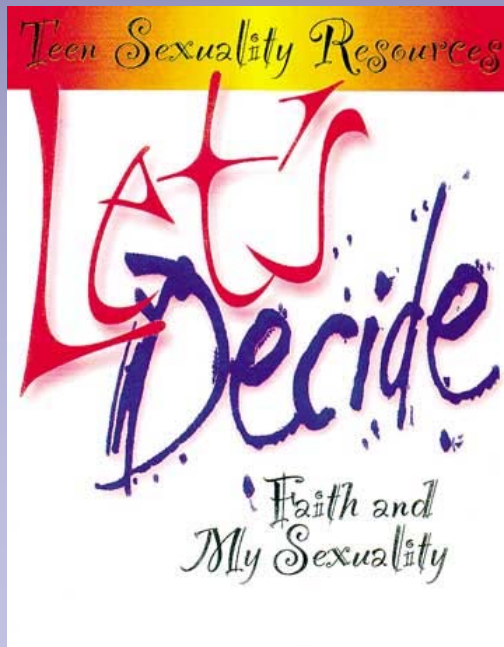
